

Infants Class News

The children are really enjoying reader's theatre, this term in Creative and Practical Arts. Reader's theatre is a way to involve students in reading aloud. In reader's theatre, students "perform" by reading scripts created from grade-level books or stories. Usually they do so without costumes or props.

Reader's theatre is a strategy that combines reading practice and performing. Its goal is to enhance students' reading skills and confidence by having them practice reading with a purpose. Reader's theatre gives students a real reason to read aloud. It also motivates reluctant readers and provides fluent readers the opportunity to explore genre and characterisation. In reader's theatre the children practice re-reading, which is a key factor in developing fluency.

Today the children performed, *The Day the Crayons Quit*, to the Primary class. They were very excited about sharing this performance with their older peers.

Primary Class Creative Arts

Primary class have been enjoying art lessons on Monday afternoons this semester with Miss Goonan. There are 7 elements that artists can consider when making art. These include colour, form, space, value, texture, shape and line. We have been learning about how to use perspective in our art which is part of the space element.

We have completed a range of successful art projects showing different perspectives including our one-point perspective artworks, our hands and feet characters showing foreshadowing and we've even tried creating more challenging two-point perspective drawings. When creating our art we have discussed important concepts which include horizon line, vanishing point, foreshortening, foreground, background and middle ground.
