Other shirts are available for purchase at Wendy's Embroidery.

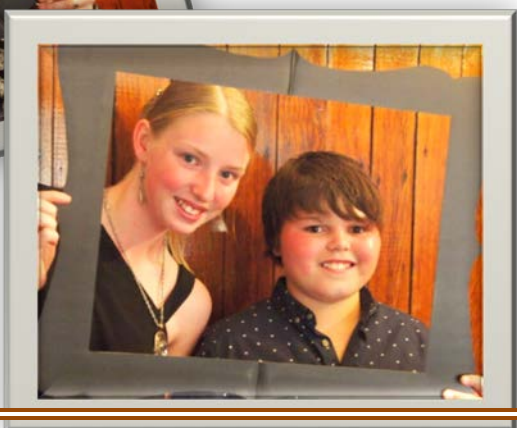
## Library Books

Thank you to those families who have returned all their library books. Notices of books still to be returned have been sent home. Keep checking under beds and in old bags, we need them back!

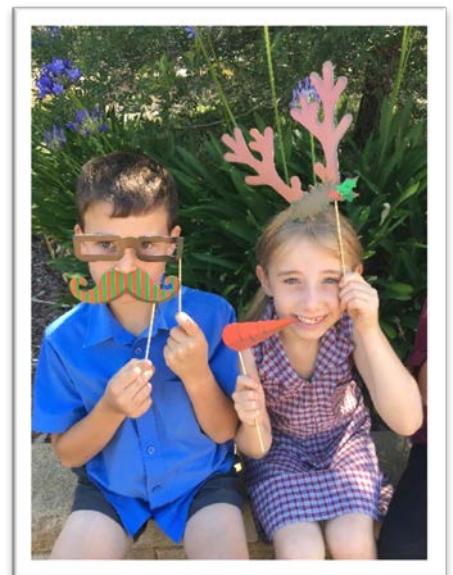

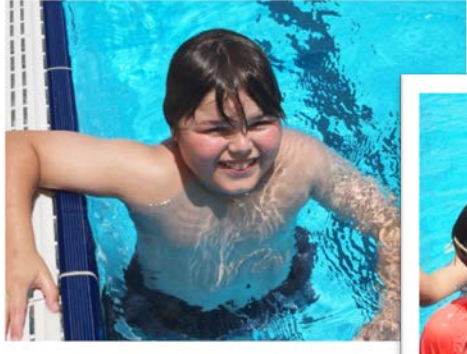
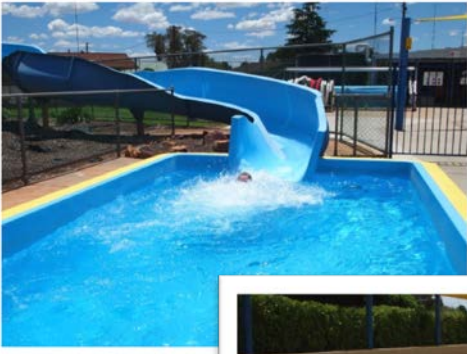
