Stage 3 Science

The Stage 3 students are studying the unit “Change Detectives” which is part of the Chemical sciences strand this term.

They have engaged in several hands-on, shared experiences of melting, evaporation and dissolving.

Their most recent experiment involved producing a chemical reaction and creating bubbles in water. The students discovered that for bubbles (a gas) to appear in the distilled water, both solutions (bicarbonate soda and citric acid) were needed for the reaction (the bubbles!)

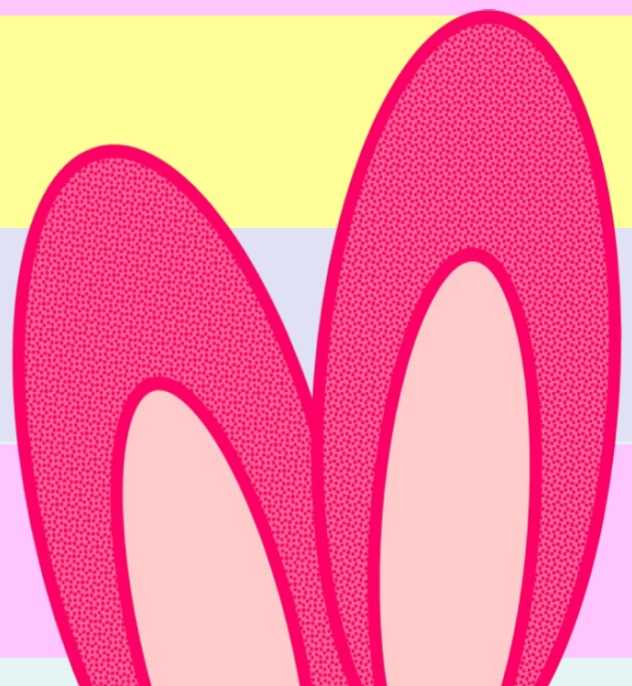
Easter Colouring Competition
