Anzac day in Tallimba will be once again be a community gathering

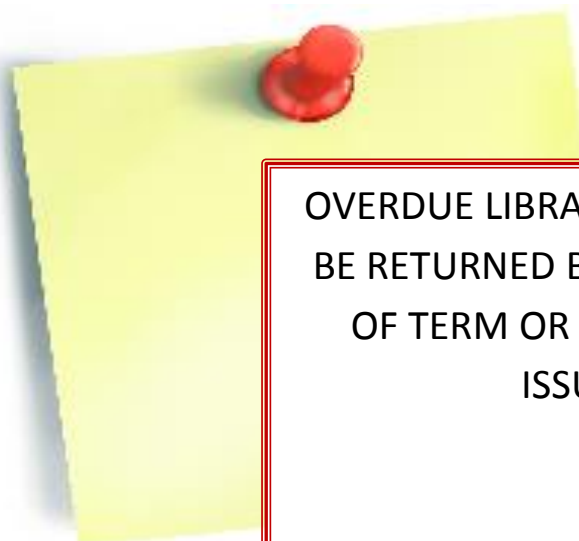
The March will start promptly at 3pm. Please gather in the main street a 2.45 pm.

If each family could please bring either a plate of Anzac biscuits or sandwiches, it would be much appreciated.

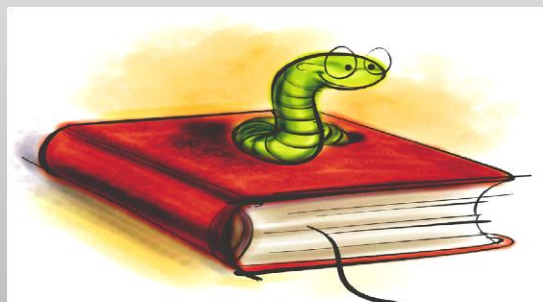
