Good luck Oliver and Chelsea who are competing in the Western District Cross Country tomorrow.

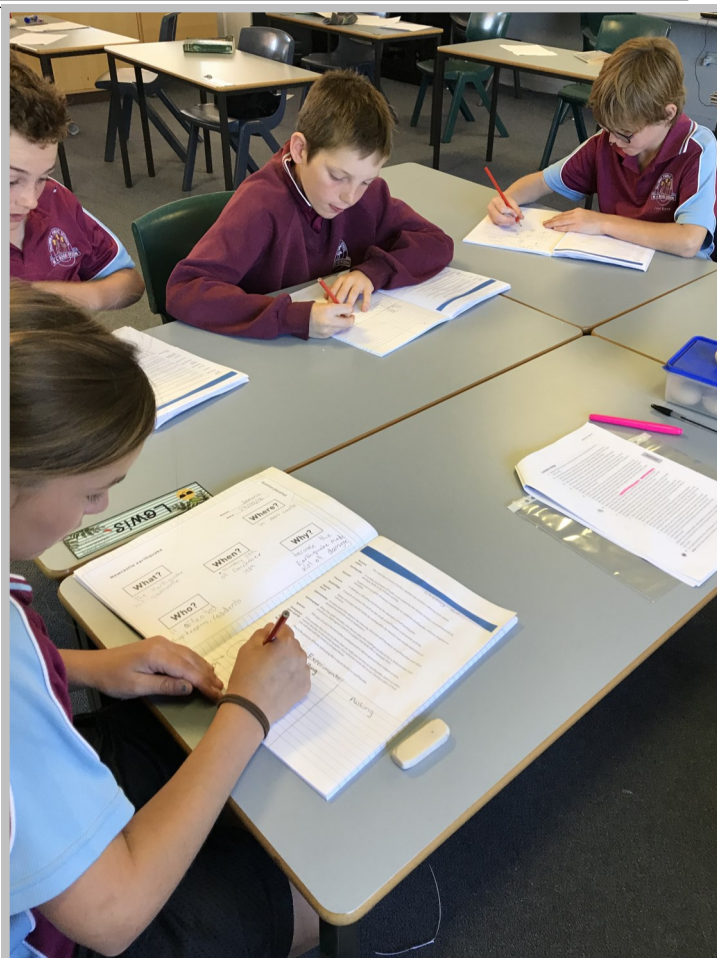

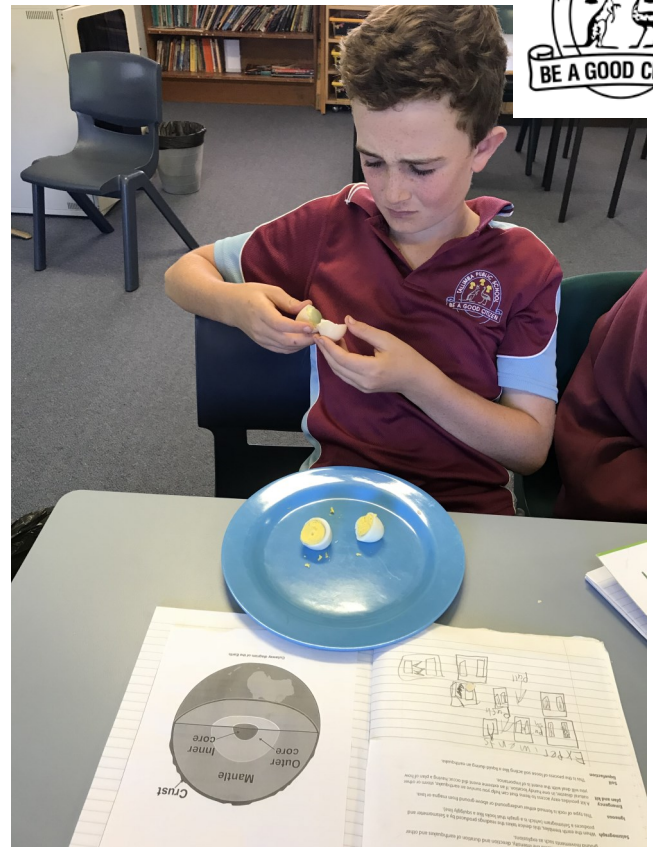
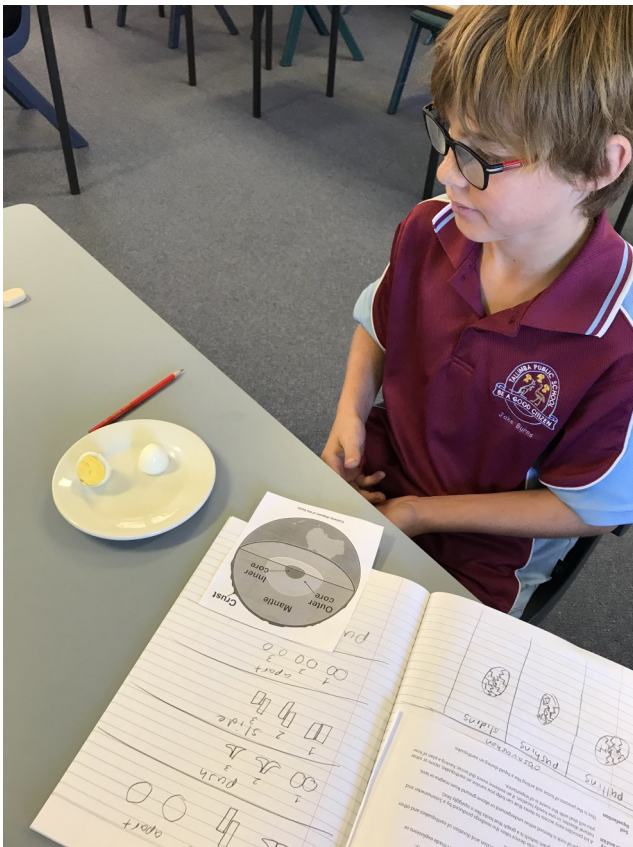

STAGE 3 - SCIENCE

Stage 3 has been learning about Earthquakes in Science. So far we have posed questions, discussed what we knew and what we wanted to find out. We discussed how the effects, magnitude and intensity of earthquakes are measured as well as conducted an experiment which modelled the changes the Earth's surface which cause earthquakes.
