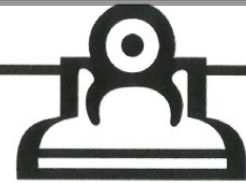


Infants Class Reward

ACCESS TO THE CENTRE IS NOT AVAILABLE PRIOR TO 8.30AM

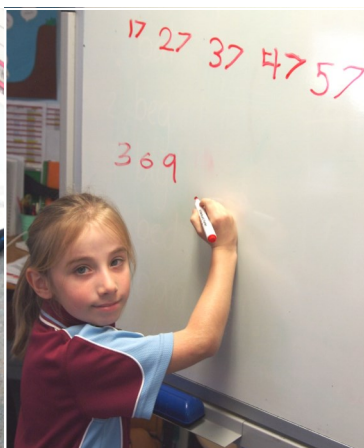
