We are excited about our end of term assembly which will be next Friday the 6<sup>th</sup> July starting at 2.00pm. Looking forward to seeing you there.



### Responsible Pet Ownership


Sam meeting Winnie. Winnie's owner Katie Starr presented students with lots of useful information about meeting, getting to know and taking care of dogs.
