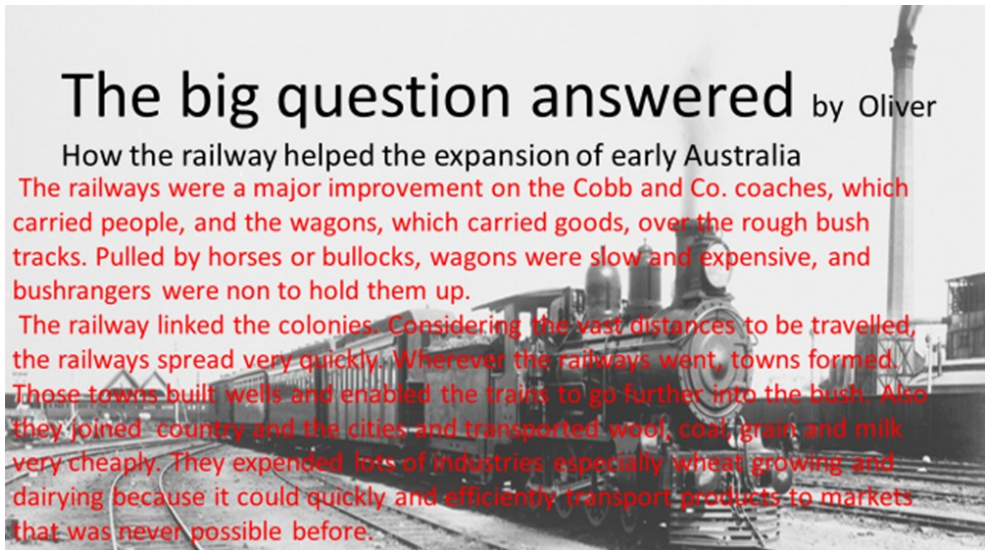
# Stage 3 History

## The big question answered by Oliver

How the railway helped the expansion of early Australia

The railways were a major improvement on the Cobb and Co. coaches, which carried people, and the wagons, which carried goods, over the rough bush tracks. Pulled by horses or bullocks, wagons were slow and expensive, and bushrangers were non to hold them up.

The railway linked the colonies. Considering the vast distances to be travelled, the railways spread very quickly. Wherever the railways went, towns formed. Those towns built wells and enabled the trains to go further into the bush. Also they joined country and the cities and transported wool, coal, grain and milk very cheaply. They expended lots of industries especially wheat growing and dairying because it could quickly and efficiently transport products to markets that was never possible before.

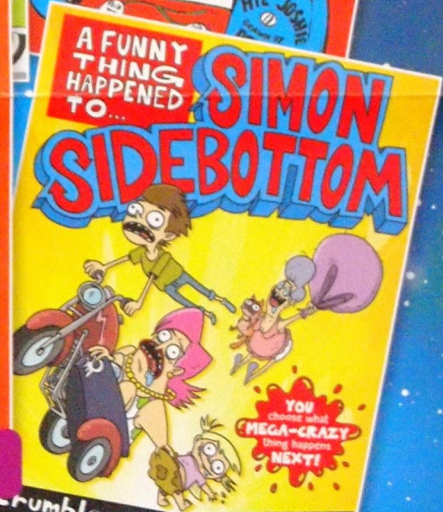
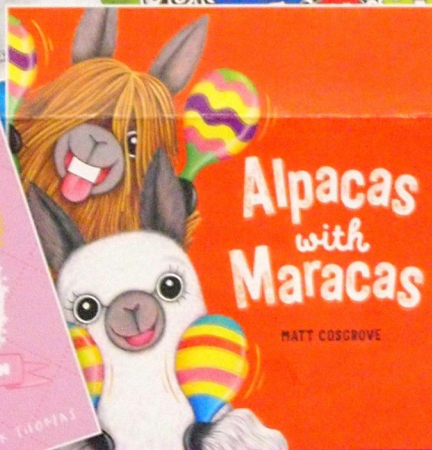
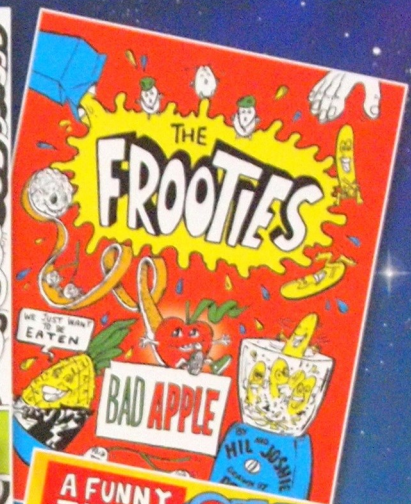
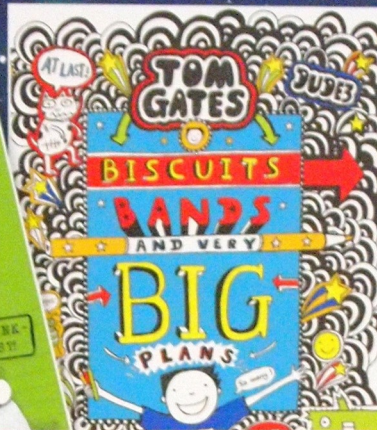
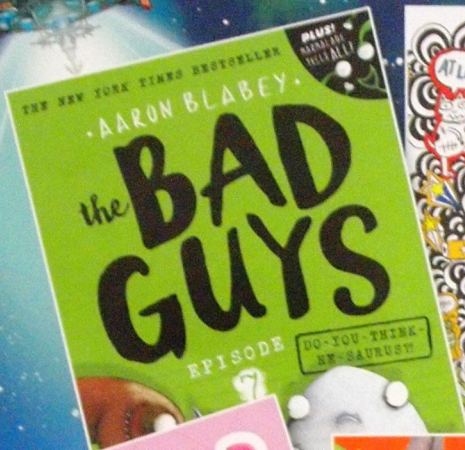
