RIEN Learning Events in Term 3

RIEN stands for Rural Innovative Education Network and is comprised of 7 small schools including Weethalle, Beckom, Binya, Rankins Springs, Naradhan, Euabalong West and Tallimba. Primary students will have the opportunity to participate in three RIEN learning events with other students in small schools this term including the Spelling Bee for Years 3-6 this week, Debating for Stage 3 and Public Speaking for Stage 2 later in the term.

RIEN Spelling Bee- via VC

This Wednesday 1st August all primary students will have the opportunity to participate in the RIEN Small Schools Network Spelling Bee. The event will be coordinated by Rankins Springs Public School via video conference (VC). There will be a junior competition for Years 3 and 4, followed by the senior competition for Years 5 and 6. The competition will begin at 9:15am.

Students are given words chosen randomly from a set list and will hear the word put into a sentence. They are given 45 seconds to say the word, spell each letter in correct order, then repeat the word again to indicate they have finished their turn. If they are correct they will progress to the next level of words of increasing difficulty. When a student is given a word they can ask for it to be repeated and they can ask to hear the definition from the announcer.


We encourage students to practice spelling words aloud at home in preparation for the Spelling Bee.

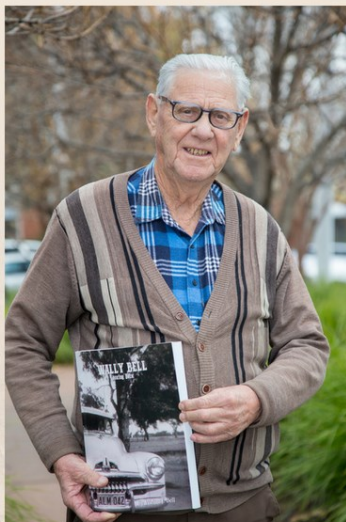
