am looking forward to thanking you all personally at our next P&C meeting which is Friday the 31<sup>st</sup> of August, commencing at 1.30pm.

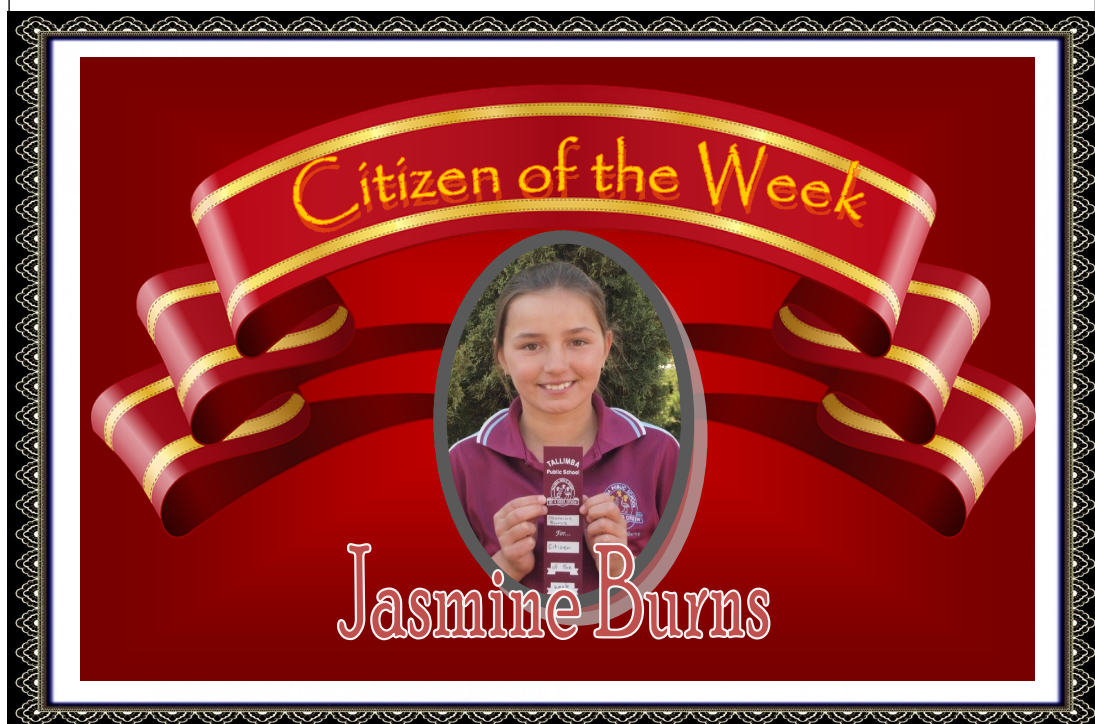
