

Congratulations to Jake Burns who is our Citizen of the Week. Jake always tries his best and has a positive attitude towards school. He is always there to lend a helping hand. Well









This year we chose to hold a Remembrance Day service at school to honour the fallen who gave their lives so that we could enjoy the way of life we have today.















