Our gardening program continues next week with Nell running Lunch and recess interest groups. All children will have a chance over the term to help Nell in the garden.

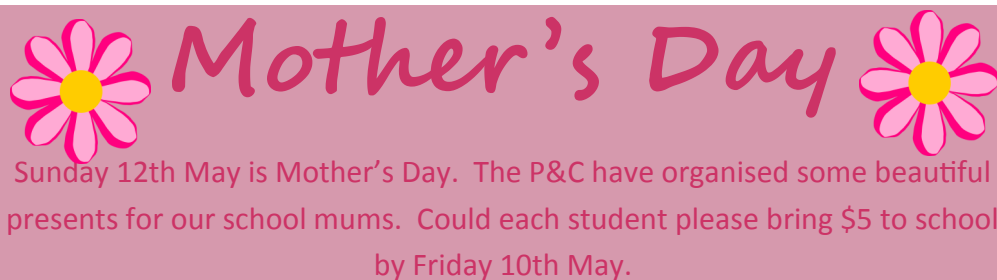

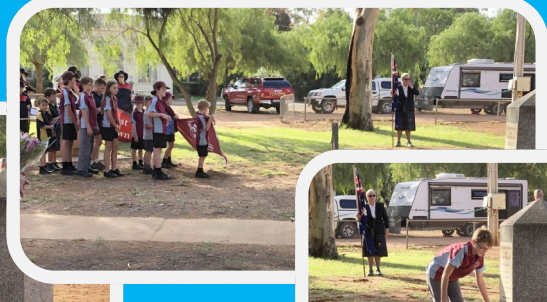
Thanks to the P & C for organising the Mother's Day Stall this Friday. Details are below.
