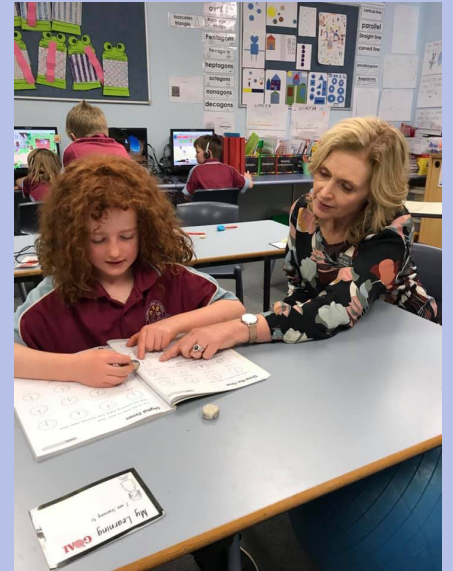
Congratulations to Teleah Oxenbridge who is our Citizen of the Week. Teleah is a kind, cooperative student who always gives her best.

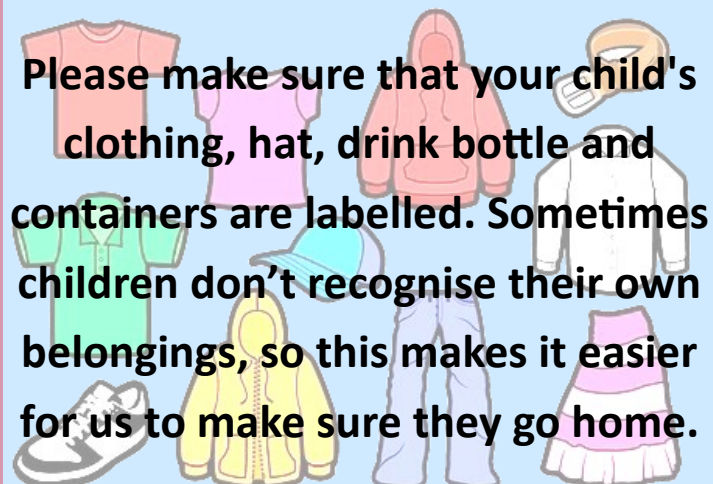
