I learnt that leadership is about people not position or power. The 4 core characteristics of leadership are; empathy, reliability, the ability to help others and to be focused on others.

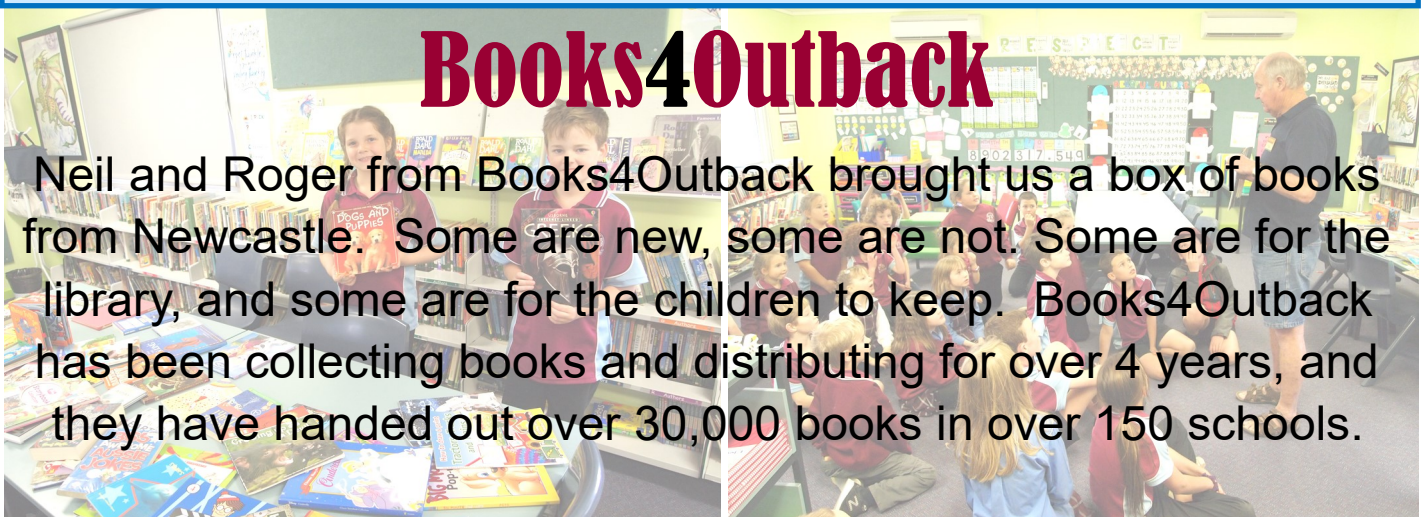
Some ways to make a contribution to my team are:

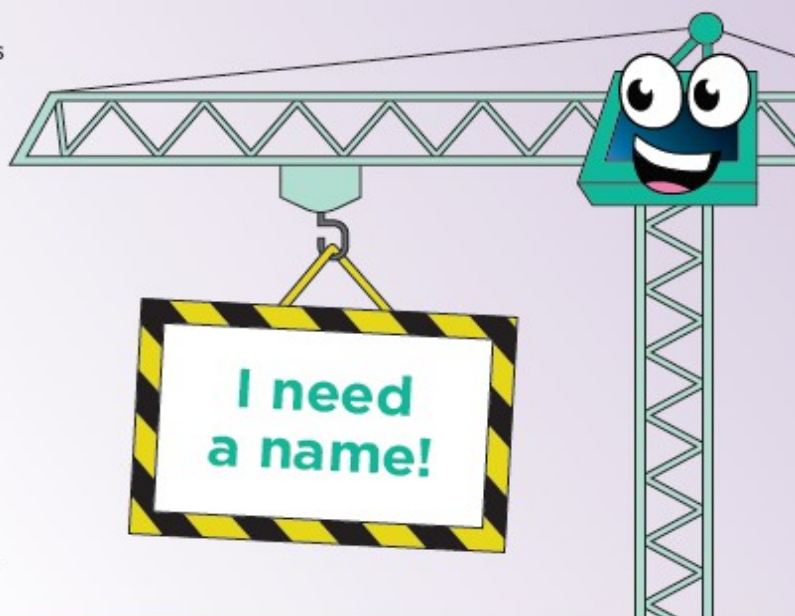
