We thank everyone involved in the CWA for the continued support that they offer our students.



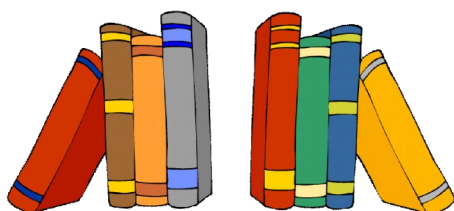
