40-day challenge



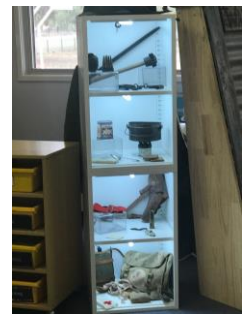
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WW1 Living History/Science Day

Drought Assistance

It's expected that a new round of household bill support payments administered via Vinnies and the Salvo's will be released next week. Each charity will have \$15m to distribute across drought impacted areas in all states.

All businesses or employees that are dependant on farming income, including contractors, are eligible to apply for this, if they are suffering from hardship due to drought. The support is up to \$3000 to assist with household bills.
