We would like to extend a massive thank you to the community of Ulladulla, who generously donated to the Tallimba, Weethalle and Yalgogrin areas.

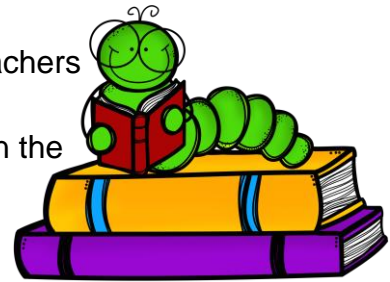
