



School Swimming and Water Safety Program



Whole School Mathematics

with Mrs Quade

For the remainder of this term, the whole school focus in Mathematics will be on chance. Stage 1 has been involved in activities relating to everyday events using the language 'likely', 'unlikely', 'certain' or 'impossible'. This might include statements such as 'If I roll the die, it is impossible that I roll a 7'.

Stage 2 have been exploring chance experiments, considering the possible outcomes of choosing from three different coloured t-shirts and a pair of shorts, for example. Ordering the chance of events occurring and the chance of everyday events happening at the same time or not, are other areas of focus for Year 3 and 4.

In Stage 3, students have been recognising that probabilities range from 0 to 1 and begin by using chance words on an interval from zero to one, to order these words. We are working towards observing the frequencies across experiments with expected frequencies. For example, on a spinner, green is more likely to occur than red or grey or blue, when green is half the area of the spinner. At the end of Stage 3, students are also describing probabilities as fractions, decimals and percentages.

Go Fish

Collecting and solving doubles

Stage 1 Thinking mathematically resource - Go fish - collecting and solving doubles (google.com)

How to play

- Each player gets 7 cards. The rest of the cards are placed in a pile in the middle as the draw pile.
- Players try to make matches, that is, pairs of cards that are the same.
- Once players can't make any more matches using their own cards, they can take turns to ask their opponent for a card.
 - o If their opponent has a card of that number they must give it to the asking player.
 - o If they don't, they say 'go fish' and the player gets a card from the central pile of cards.





- For the player to keep the match they must solve the doubles fact. For example, if a player collected a double 9, they must solve and say 'double 9 is 18' to their opponent.
- If at any point a player has no cards left, they can pick up another 7 cards from the draw pile.
- Play continues until there are no cards left in the draw pile and/or all matches have been made.
- The player with the most matches at the end is the winner!
