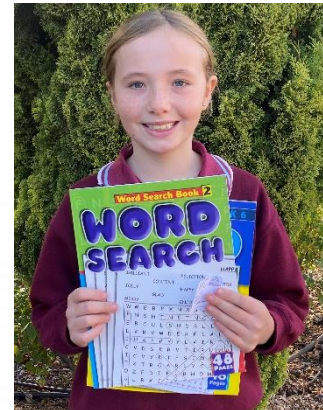

## Year 1/2/3 & Miss Lord

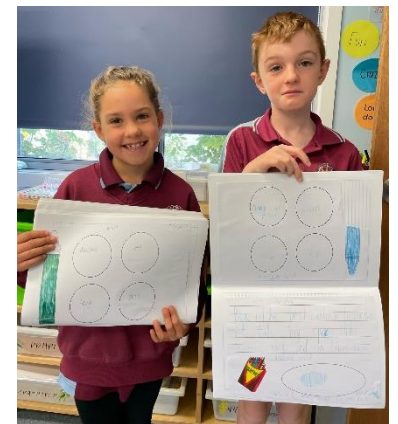
In English this term, students are exploring persuasive texts. As a class we read the story 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt. Students have been focusing on low and high modality words and discussed how to choose or make words more powerful in their writing.



In Science this term, Stage 1 are investigating observable changes that occur in the sky and on the land. Students are currently looking at the patterns of the Sun's path in the sky and the appearance of the moon and stars at night.



In Geography, Stage 1 are looking at Australia's location in the world through the eyes of an intergalactic traveller. They are exploring Australia as a continent on a planet called Earth and we were able to use an intergalactic GPS to identify Australia's and Tallimba's position on Earth.



Our vegetable garden is booming with celery and spinach. During recess this week, students enjoyed picking and eating some produce.

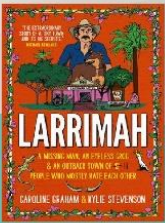
