Next Wednesday 6th March, we welcome our visiting author Dub Leffler to our school. Dub is Australia's Premier Indigenous illustrator of children's books and has taught Illustration workshops in over 200 schools across Australia and abroad. He is also a writer, animator and mixed media artist, working in the arts through books, film, television, muralism and art education.

### Stage 3 History

In class, Year 5 and 6 have been developing their understanding of migration and its impact on the development of Australia as a nation. 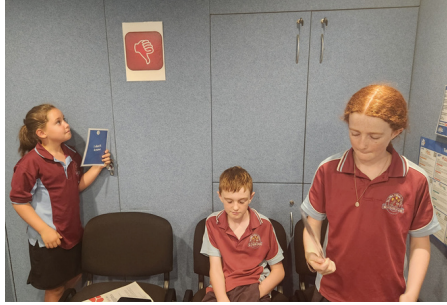
